

ACEP Nurse of the Year Nomination Procedure

1. Each year the Maryland Council of the Emergency Nurses Association (MDENA) will post a call for nominations for the MD Emergency Nurse of the Year (for the following year) on the website beginning in October. The Nomination for Maryland Emergency Nurse of the Year form will be used.
2. Nominations will be collected by the State President until December 31.
3. Once collected the forms are distributed to the attendees at the next state council meeting with the names of the applicants blocked.
4. A vote will be taken at the first council meeting in the new year to determine the winner. If an attendee is a nominee and is present, he/she will be excused from the voting and from the room while the voting is occurring.
5. The State President will promptly notify Maryland American College of Emergency Physicians (MD ACEP) in writing/email with an edited copy of the nomination form so that they may make preparations for presentation of the award at the spring conference.
6. The State President should attend the ACEP conference so as to introduce the winner.
